CARAVAN OF HOPE VOICES FROM THE MARGINS

From 5-18 November 2022, as world leaders gather in Egypt for the COP27 global climate talks and debate on the future of our planet, we will run the Caravan of Hope – Voices from the Margins COP27 Series. This is an online and in person programme aimed at presenting and amplifying the voices (stories, issues, concerns and actions) of frontline communities that was captured during the Heal the Earth Caravan of Hope 2022 Tour in Chimanimani (Zimbabwe), Beira (Mozambique) and Chikwawa (Malawi). These three places are some of the most affected areas by climate-induced floods and cyclones in Southern Africa. In fact, over the past ten years these areas have experienced back-to-back climate related disasters that have left severe destruction, loss and damage.

The Voices from the Margins COP27 Series will therefore highlight the voices of these frontline communities, young people, women and others who have been marginalized and excluded in global platforms and processes such as COP27. We will discuss the climate injustices they face and how climate change is disproportionately impacting them and other people from the global south. Thus, in the series, we will be demanding for 'climate justice now' and advocating that the voice of those most vulnerable and affected (indigenous, poor and marginalised people) is heard and placed at the centre of global climate negotiations and response efforts. We will also imagine the future we want to build and strategise on inclusive solutions towards that future and ensuring that no one is left behind.

You are invited to join us and take part in this series through our online sessions (see Events Schedule/Programme) or by organizing similar activities in your country to mobilise for climate justice at COP27.
